(a) When residential real estate valuation services are ordered in connection with any real estate transaction and the valuation services are coordinated by an appraisal management company, as defined in Section 34-27A-2, Code of Alabama 1975, the appraisal fee and any fee charged by the appraisal management company shall be disclosed separately and distinctly on the closing statement.

8 (b) The Alabama Real Estate Appraisers Board may
9 adopt applicable rules pursuant to this act.

10 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 11 first day of the third month following its passage and 12 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
