1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

2 Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the 3 Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the Board of 4 Home Medical Equipment until October 1, 2022.

5 Section 2. The existence and functioning of the 6 Board of Home Medical Equipment, created and functioning 7 pursuant to Sections 34-14C-1 to 34-14C-8, inclusive, Code of 8 Alabama 1975, is continued until October 1, 2022, and those 9 code sections are expressly preserved.

10 Section 3. The Legislature concurs in the 11 recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in 12 Sections 1 and 2 of this act.

Section 4. This act shall become effective
immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
its otherwise becoming law.
