16 WHEREAS, the Department of Forensic Sciences  
17 certified to the Legislative Reference Service (now known as  
18 the Legislative Services Agency, Legal Division) the adoption  
19 of the proposed new rule on April 14, 2017, which was the  
20 subject of review at a meeting of the Joint Committee on  
21 Administrative Regulation Review on May 17, 2017; and

22 WHEREAS, after hearing from interested persons, the  
23 Joint Committee, in accordance with Section 41-22-23, Code of  
24 Alabama 1975, disapproved the proposed new rule; now
