5	JOINT LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING CAHAWBA AS
6	THE FIRST PERMANENT CAPITAL OF THE STATE OF ALABAMA.

8	WHEREAS, bound by rivers on three sides, the Town of
9	Cahawba, spelled "Cahaba" after 1850, boasts a long history of
10	settlement including Native Americans and French, British, and
11	Spanish colonist; and
12	WHEREAS, empowered by the state Legislature to
13	establish a permanent capital in Cahawba, William Wyatt Bibb,
14	Alabama's first Governor, patterned the town on Philadelphia
15	and secured the construction of a two-story statehouse; and
16	WHEREAS, Cahawba was the capital of Alabama from
17	1820 to 1826, through the state's first four governors, eleven
18	meetings of the state Supreme Court, and seven sessions of the
19	Legislature, including the state's first special session,
20	which dealt with reapportionment; and
21	WHEREAS, many of the laws and judicial rulings which
22	provided the foundation for the new state's government were
23	enacted at Cahawba; and
24	WHEREAS, during its service as the state's capital,
25	Cahawba grew into a town of more than 1,000 residents, a place

1	of commerce with two newspapers and numerous inns, stores, and
2	the first state bank, built in 1824; and
3	WHEREAS, on December 13, 1825, the state Legislature
4	voted to relocate the state capital to Tuscaloosa; and
5	WHEREAS, now a property of the Alabama Historical
6	Commission, the Old Cahawba Archeological Site continues to be
7	an important resource for understanding Alabama's early
8	history as a state; and
9	WHEREAS, Alabama is currently engaged in a
10	commemoration of the Bicentennial of Statehood, a three-year
11	celebration of the people, places, and events that form our
12	rich history; now therefore,
13	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
14	HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That we do hereby recognize Cahawba
15	as the first permanent capital of the State of Alabama.
