11 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE LEGISLATURE OF
12 ALABAMA, That having been approved by three-fifths of the
13 members elected to the Senate, this body, pursuant to Section
14 284.01 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, hereby
15 determines that SB81 of the 2018 Regular Session applies only
16 to Clay County and may be adopted only by a favorable vote of
17 a majority of the qualified electors of Clay County.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That having been approved by
19 three-fifths of the members elected to the Senate, this body,
20 pursuant to Section 284.01 of the Constitution of Alabama of
21 1901, hereby determines that SB145 of the 2018 Regular Session
22 applies only to Jackson County and may be adopted only by a
23 favorable vote of a majority of the qualified electors of
24 Jackson County.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That having been approved by
26 three-fifths of the members elected to the Senate, this body,
27 pursuant to Section 284.01 of the Constitution of Alabama of

1 1901, hereby determines that SB216 of the 2018 Regular Session
2 applies only to Morgan County and may be adopted only by a
3 favorable vote of a majority of the qualified electors of
4 Morgan County.

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That having been approved by
6 three-fifths of the members elected to the Senate, this body,
7 pursuant to Section 284.01 of the Constitution of Alabama of
8 1901, hereby determines that HB33 of the 2018 Regular Session
9 (Act 2018-17) applies only to Calhoun County and may be
10 adopted only by a favorable vote of a majority of the
11 qualified electors of Calhoun County.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That having been approved by
13 three-fifths of the members elected to the Senate, this body,
14 pursuant to Section 284.01 of the Constitution of Alabama of
15 1901, hereby determines that HB168 of the 2018 Regular Session
16 (Act 2018-37) applies only to Clay County and may be adopted
17 only by a favorable vote of a majority of the qualified
18 electors of Clay County.
