8 COMMENDING MR. ALAN W. FUTVOYE FOR OUTSTANDING
9 PROFESSIONAL ACHIEVEMENT ON THE OCCASION OF HIS RETIREMENT
10 FROM THE BUREAU OF ALCOHOL, TOBACCO, FIREARMS AND EXPLOSIVES.

12 WHEREAS, highest commendations are herein proudly
13 presented to Senior Special Agent Alan W. Futvoye for his
14 distinguished record professional achievement on the occasion
15 of his retirement from the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco,
16 Firearms and Explosives after 30 years of distinguished
17 service to the people of Alabama and the United States of
18 America; and

19 WHEREAS, Senior Agent Futvoye was sworn in as a
20 Special Agent with the (ATF) on February 21, 1989, where he
21 was assigned to the Gulfport, Mississippi, Field Office; in
22 November 1999, Special Agent Futvoye was transferred to the
23 Jackson, Mississippi, Field Office; in October 2012, he was
24 assigned to the National Center for Explosives, Training, and
25 Research (NCETR) in Huntsville at Redstone Arsenal, where he
26 served as the Project Officer and later as the Program Manager
27 for the Advanced Explosives Disposal Techniques (AEDT); and

1 WHEREAS, during his 30-year career, Special Agent
2 Futvoye enforced the federal firearms, explosives, and arson
3 laws; in addition, he was a member of the of ATF's Regional
4 Special Response Team (SRT), an SRT Medic, a Special Agent
5 Certified Explosives Specialist (SACES), and one of the
6 original members of the Enhanced Undercover Program (EUP); and

7 WHEREAS, as an SRT member and medic, Special Agent
8 Futvoye supported many high-risk operations involving
9 notorious street gangs and outlaw motorcycle gangs throughout
10 the United States; and

11 WHEREAS, as an EUP member, Special Agent Futvoye
12 served in an undercover capacity in 2001, as a member of the
13 "Loan Few" motorcycle gang, where he and a local law
14 enforcement officer infiltrated the "Sons of Silence"
15 Motorcycle Gang; in 2003, during Operation Black Biscuit he
16 served in a undercover capacity as a member of the "Solo
17 Angels" Motorcycle Gang, targeting the Hells Angels Motorcycle
18 Gang; and 2019, during "Operation Green Stallion", he and
19 other undercover agents purchased firearms and drugs from gang
20 members throughout the city of Oceanside, California; and

21 WHEREAS, as a SACES, Special Agent Futvoye was
22 assigned to several high-profile search events investigations;
23 he supported the Summer Olympics 1996, Super Bowl XXXVI in
24 2002, and Super Bowl XXXVII in 2004; in 2010, SACES Alan
25 Futvoye deployed twice to Afghanistan, delivery Post Blast
26 Training to the United States Military and the Afghanistan
27 National Police: and

1 WHEREAS, as the PM of AEDT, Special Agent Futvoye is
2 responsible for training approximately 500 public safety bomb
3 technicians yearly, providing in depth classroom and range
4 instruction in virtually every aspect of explosives disposal;
5 Special Agent Futvoye is highly respected; and

6 WHEREAS, the distinguished career of Special Agent
7 Futvoye was marked by dedicated service to his state and
8 country; he personified the finest qualities of those
9 individuals devoted and dedicated to protecting others; now
10 therefore,

11 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
12 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That Senior Special Agent Alan W.
13 Futvoye is highly honored and commended, and this resolution
