11 WHEREAS, highest commendations are herein presented  
12 to Ms. Michelle Head who will be honored by the Willie A. and  
13 Betty C. Farrior Family Foundation during its Leadership  
14 Luncheon on Saturday, March 23, 2019, in the Talladega  
15 Regional Family Life Center for her Outstanding Service to the

17 WHEREAS, the Willie A. and Betty C. Farrior Family  
18 Foundation is a nonprofit organization established March 2017,  
19 by Colonel (Retired) Cedrick A. Farrior in memory of Mr. and  
20 Mrs. Farrior; both were native Alabamians who unfortunately  
21 lost their vision at an early age; they attended the Alabama  
22 School for the Negro Blind in Talladega, Alabama; they were  
23 married in October 1945; Willie was the first Black blind  
24 individual to be employed at the Alabama Industries for the  
25 Blind in June 1950; Willie retired from AIDB after completion  
26 of 40 years of employment; Betty retired after completion of  
27 27 years of employment; and

1               WHEREAS, Ms. Michelle Head is currently the  
2               principal of Stemley Road Elementary School; she is completing  
3               her 26th year in education with 13 years in Talladega County;  
4               Ms. Head graduated from Winterboro High School and the  
5               University of Montevallo with an Educational Specialist Degree  
6               in 2001; she relocated from Shelby County to her roots in  
7               hopes of serving her community, especially the children; and

8               WHEREAS, Ms. Head states, "We must all honor  
9               childhood, protect children from barriers and provide support  
10              to schools"; she is a believer in the power of community based  
11              partnerships; as a member of Alpine Baptist Church, she sees  
12              the benefits when schools are supported through a strong  
13              volunteer program; she believes that, "When we work as one,  
14              the children are better prepared for the future; now  
15              therefore,
