13 shall not include conduct that is protected under the First
14 Amendment to the United States Constitution or Article I,
15 Section 4 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901. Such
16 protected conduct includes, but is not limited to, lawful
17 protests and counter-protests in the outdoor areas of campus
18 generally accessible to members of the public, except during
19 times when those areas have been reserved in advance for other
20 events, or minor, brief, or fleeting nonviolent disruptions of
21 events that are isolated and short in duration.

23 On page 6, line 3, delete "develop, adopt, and
24 enforce" and insert in lieu thereof the following language:
