19	To amend Section 16-64-4, Code of Alabama 1975,
20	relating to tuition rates at institutions of higher education;
21	to extend from 50 to 275, the number of miles from campus that
22	the county of residence of a nonresident student may be, for
23	that student to be granted resident tuition rates.
24	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
25	Section 1. Section 16-64-4 of the Code of Alabama
26	1975, is amended to read as follows:
27	"\$16-64-4.

"(a) Each Alabama public institution of higher education shall charge each undergraduate student who is registered as a nonresident a minimum tuition of two times the resident tuition rate charged by that institution. This rate shall be effective for students who register at an institution beginning August 1, 1997. A nonresident graduate student at an institution shall be charged a rate of tuition that is at least at the level of tuition charged to a nonresident undergraduate.

"(b) The governing boards of each four-year public institution of higher education and Athens State University shall retain the power to extend resident tuition rates to students who reside in any county within 50 275 miles of a campus of the institution; provided, however, that campus must be in existence and operating as of January 1, 1996. For public two-year institutions, not including Athens State University, the State Board of Education Board of Trustees of the Alabama Community College System, upon the recommendation of the Chancellor of the Department of Postsecondary Education, shall retain the power to extend resident tuition rates to students who reside in any county within 50 miles of a campus of the institution; provided, however, that campus must be in existence and operating as of January 1, 1996.

"(c) Any provision of law to the contrary notwithstanding, the governing boards of each four-year public institution of higher education and Athens State University shall retain the power to set tuition rates for programs that

are delivered in a distance format to students who are not 1 2 present within the boundaries of the state at the time the distance program is delivered. For public two-year 3 institutions of higher education, except Athens State 4 5 University, the State Board of Education Board of Trustees of the Alabama Community College System, upon the recommendation of the Chancellor of the Department of Postsecondary Education, shall retain the power to set tuition rates for programs that are delivered in a distance format for students 9 10 who are not present within the boundaries of the state at the time the distance program is delivered." 11 12 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 13 first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law. 14
