Sections (3) and (4) and renumber the subsequent section

accordingly:

Section 3. The department shall provide a report to the Legislature on or before the first day of the 2020 Regular Session regarding tax revenues generated by retail sales delivered into a location in Alabama in which the seller does not have an actual physical presence. The department shall be authorized to obtain, from local taxing jurisdictions and taxpayers, the information needed to compile the report required by this section.

Section 4. Effective with taxes collected after January 2020, twenty-five percent (25%) of the portion of the proceeds allocated to the county general fund as prescribed in subsection (b) of Section 40-23-197 shall be distributed by the county to the local boards of education. In all counties having more than one local board of education, such allocation shall be distributed within such county on the same basis of the total calculated costs for the Foundation Program for those local boards of education within the county. The

allocations provided for in this section shall not be subject to amendment or reallocation by any local law enacted after July 1, 2019. Should the distribution of the portion of the proceeds allocated to the state as provided for in subsection (a) of Section 40-23-197 be amended to increase the portion allocated to the Education Trust Fund, the allocation of the county portion provided for herein shall be adjusted in like manner and percentage.
