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9 A BILL  
10 TO BE ENTITLED  
11 AN ACT  
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13 To authorize the Town Council of the Town of Triana  
14 in Madison County, pursuant to Amendment No. 373 of the  
15 Constitution of Alabama 1901, to increase the rate of the  
16 town's general ad valorem tax levied and collected on all  
17 taxable property in the town which is authorized pursuant to  
18 the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, by an additional 12 mills  
19 on each dollar (\$1.20 on each one hundred dollars) of assessed  
20 value to be used exclusively for educational purposes.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

22 Section 1. This act shall apply to the Town of  
23 Triana in Madison County.

24 Section 2. For the purposes of this act, the  
25 following words have the following meanings:

1                   (1) AMENDMENT NO 373. Amendment No. 373 of the  
2 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 217  
3 of the Recompiled Constitution of Alabama of 1901.

4                   (2) Town. The Town of Triana, Alabama.

5                   (3) TOWN GENERAL AD VALOREM TAX. The tax authorized  
6 pursuant to the applicable provisions of the general laws of  
7 this state and the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to be  
8 levied by the town for general municipal purposes and without  
9 express limit as to time.

10                   Section 3. The town presently levies and collects  
11 the town general ad valorem tax. Pursuant to a resolution  
12 adopted by the Town Council of the Town of Triana after a  
13 public hearing in accordance with Amendment No. 373, the Town  
14 of Triana proposes to increase the rate at which it may levy  
15 and collect the town general ad valorem tax by an additional  
16 12 mills (\$1.20 on each one hundred dollars) of assessed  
17 value.

18                   Section 4. Pursuant to subsection (f) of Amendment  
19 No. 373 and a resolution adopted by the Town Council of the  
20 Town of Triana after a public hearing, the town may increase  
21 the rate at which the town levies and collects the town  
22 general ad valorem tax by a maximum rate increase for any tax  
23 year equal to 12 mills (\$1.20 on each one hundred dollars) of  
24 assessed value, to be used and expended exclusively for public  
25 educational purposes.

26                   Section 5. The increase in the rate at which the  
27 town general ad valorem tax may be levied and collected

1 pursuant to this act is subject to approval by a majority of  
2 the qualified electors residing in the town who vote on the  
3 proposed increase at a special election called and held for  
4 that purpose pursuant to subsection (f) of Amendment No. 373.

5 Section 6. The increase in the rate of ad valorem  
6 tax authorized by this act upon approval of a majority of the  
7 qualified electors residing in the town shall be levied only  
8 if the City of Madison also approves a 12 mill increase in the  
9 rate of its ad valorem tax at a special election held  
10 contemporaneously with the special election held in the Town  
11 of Triana, the proceeds of which are to be used exclusively  
12 for public educational purposes.

13 Section 7. The increase in the maximum level of ad  
14 valorem tax authorized pursuant to this act may be made  
15 effective beginning with the levy for the tax year beginning  
16 on October 1, 2019, for which tax year municipal ad valorem  
17 taxes will become due and payable on October 1, 2020.

18 Section 8. This act shall become effective  
19 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
20 governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
