16	civil liability for negligence claimed by the individual
17	receiving the transportation, if the provider could not have
18	reasonably anticipated the particular harm caused by the
19	negligent act while acting in the line and scope of a
20	volunteer in providing transportation, or the act or omission
21	was the result of the provider's willful or wanton misconduct.
22	The immunity provided in this subsection includes
23	transportation from an individual's residence.
24	(b) Acceptance by the transportation provider of a
25	gratuitous contribution or donation made by the individual
26	receiving transportation services does not constitute a waiver

of immunity under this section.
