9 A BILL
10 TO BE ENTITLED
11 AN ACT
12

13 To alter, rearrange, and extend the boundary lines
14 and corporate limits of the Town of Gordonville in Lowndes
15 County.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

17 Section 1. The boundary lines and corporate limits
18 of the Town of Gordonville in Lowndes County are altered,
19 rearranged, and extended to include within the corporate
20 limits of the municipality, in addition to the lands now
21 included, all of the following territory:

22 A 1.0 acre tract in the Northeast Quarter of Section
23 12, T13N, R13E, Lowndes County, Alabama described as follows:
24 Commencing from a concrete monument at the locally accepted
25 Southeast corner of the West Half of the East Half of
26 Section12, T13N, R13E, Lowndes County, Alabama; thence from
27 the point of commencement S 87 degrees 42' 15" W a distance of

1 659.88 feet to a found angle iron; thence S 88 degrees 23' 11"
2 W a distance of 113.23 feet to the point of beginning of the
3 Orbuty Ozier property; thence S 87 degrees 48' 15" W from the
4 point of beginning a distance of 291.00 feet to a point on the
5 curve of the easterly right of way of the Mount Willing-Benton
6 Road, said curve having a central angle of 08 degrees 41' 14",
7 a radius of 990.94 feet with the radius point being located
8 East of the easterly right of way of said Mount Willing-Benton
9 Road, and a chord of 150.10 feet with a chord bearing of N 00
10 degrees 03'36" W, thence Northwest along the curve of the
11 easterly right of way of said Mount Willing-Benton Road to the
12 end of said curve; thence N 87 degrees 48'15" E a distance of
13 285.41 feet; thence S 02 degrees 11'45" E a distance of 150.00
14 feet to the point of beginning; the said tract of land is
15 located in the Northeast Quarter of Section 12, T13N, R13E,
16 Lowndes County, Alabama and contains 1.0 acres more or less.

17 Section 2. In accordance with Section 11-42-6(b) of
18 the Code of Alabama 1975, a map showing what territory is
19 proposed to be annexed to the Town of Gordonville is on file
20 in the office of the Judge of Probate in Lowndes County,
21 Alabama, and the map is open to the inspection of the public.

22 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
23 first day of the third month following its passage and
24 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
