2 ENROLLED, An Act,

3 Relating to prostitution; to amend Section  
4 13A-6-183, Code of Alabama 1975, to allow the disclosure of a  
5 certain person's photograph after a conviction for  
6 prostitution.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

8 Section 1. Section 13A-6-183, Code of Alabama 1975,  
9 is amended to read as follows:

10 "§13A-6-183.

11 "(a) For the safety and well-being of a person  
12 arrested for the crime of prostitution under Division 2 of  
13 Article 3 of Chapter 12, he or she may be held in custody for  
14 up to 72 hours. The person shall be brought before a court of  
15 competent jurisdiction as soon as possible within a 48-hour  
16 period to conduct an inquiry into the person's access to  
17 resources, such as, but not limited to, health care, shelter,  
18 mental health counseling, or financial aid. The court may  
19 issue an order to assist the person in obtaining the services  
20 and resources needed pursuant to the court's inquiry.

21 " (b) (1) Except as provided in subdivision (2), a  
22 photograph of a person taken by a law enforcement agency upon  
23 the ~~arrest~~ conviction of a person for the crime of  
24 prostitution under Division 2 of Article 3 of Chapter 12, is  
25 not a public record and may not be published in any printed or

1 electronic media or provided to any person without an order of  
2 a district court judge with jurisdiction over the person's  
3 criminal case."

4 "(2) A photograph of a person who procures or  
5 solicits a prostitute or who provides persons or premises for  
6 prostitution purposes in violation of Section 13A-12-121, is a  
7 public record and may be published in any printed or  
8 electronic media or provided to any person without an order of  
9 the court."

10 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the  
11 first day of the third month following its passage and  
12 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
