10 TO BE ENTITLED
11 AN ACT
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13 Relating to Mobile County; to amend Section 2 and
14 Section 7 of Act 87-663, 1987 Regular Session (Acts 1987, p.
15 1172); to further provide for the acceptance of certain
16 unimproved roads and regulating the construction of certain
17 other unimproved roads.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

19 Section 1. Section 2 of Act 87-663, 1987 Regular
20 Session (Acts 1987, p. 1172), is amended to read as follows:

21 "Section 2.

22 "In order for a road to be considered under the
23 provision of this act, ~~all~~ 90 percent of the adjacent property
24 owners shall sign and submit a petition to the county
25 commission during the month of January of each year requesting
26 ~~said~~ the commission to consider the acceptance of the named
27 public road into the county road maintenance system."

1 Section 2. Section 7 of Act 87-663, 1987 Regular
2 Session (Acts 1987, p. 1172), is amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 7. The petitioners shall not submit any
4 roads for consideration in this program that do not connect
5 directly to an existing county or state maintained road. The
6 petitioners may submit a portion of the road to be considered
7 by the county in the event there are individual property
8 owners who do not wish to participate in the program and this
9 act. Individual property owners will be required to purchase
10 ~~such~~ driveway pipe as required to provide adequate drainage
11 and serve the property owner for access to the property.
12 Individual property owners will be required to execute any
13 right-of-way deeds or easements as an obligation under this
14 act at no expense to the county. Individual property owners
15 will cooperate fully with the chairperson selected in the
16 petition and coordinate any and all matters concerning the
17 road with and through that designated individual."

18 Section 2. All laws or parts of laws which conflict
19 with this act are repealed.

20 Section 3. This act shall become effective
21 immediately following its passage and approval by the
22 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
