5 (b) Any person or persons who, in good faith, makes
6 a report or causes a report to be made to the appropriate law
7 enforcement authority pursuant to subsection (a), or
8 participates in any judicial proceeding or any other
9 proceeding resulting from the report shall be immune from any
10 civil or criminal liability.

11 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
12 first day of the third month following its passage and
13 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
