1 (c) A collaborative practice agreement and any  
2 amendment thereto shall not become effective until approved by  
3 the Board of Pharmacy and the Board of Medical Examiners.

4 (d) The Board of Pharmacy and the Board of Medical  
5 Examiners shall each adopt rules to implement this act. The  
6 initial rules shall be adopted not later than October 1, 2019.

7 (e) A collaborative practice agreement between a  
8 licensed pharmacist and a licensed physician may not be  
9 approved unless both the Board of Pharmacy and Board of  
10 Medical Examiners have rules in effect implementing this  
11 section.

12 (f) Fees for physicians participating in a  
13 collaborative practice with a licensed pharmacist shall be  
14 collected and retained by the State Board of Medical  
15 Examiners. Fees for pharmacists participating in a  
16 collaborative practice with a licensed physician shall be  
17 collected and retained by the Board of Pharmacy. The fee for a  
18 physician participating in a collaborative practice shall be  
19 set by the State Board of Medical Examiners in an amount not  
20 to exceed three hundred dollars (\$300). The fee for a  
21 pharmacist participating in a collaborative practice shall be  
22 set by the Board of Pharmacy in an amount not to exceed three  
23 hundred dollars (\$300).

24 (g) Nothing in this section shall preclude a  
25 pharmacist licensed by the Board of Pharmacy employed by a  
26 licensed health care facility from executing approved medical  
27 protocols within the facility.

1                   Section 2. This act shall become effective  
2 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
3 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
