ENROLLED, An Act,

To alter, rearrange, and extend the boundary lines and corporate limits of the City of Trussville in Jefferson County and St. Clair County.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The boundary lines and corporate limits of the City of Trussville in Jefferson County and St. Clair County are altered, rearranged, and extended to include within the corporate limits of the city, in addition to the lands now included, all of the following territory:

A parcel of land situated in the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 15 South, Township 16, Range 1 East, St. Clair County, Alabama being more particularly described as follows:

Commence at a 3" capped pipe at the NE corner of Section 15, Township 16 South, Range 1 East, St. Clair County, Alabama; thence S 87 degrees 39 minutes 57 seconds W along the north line of the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of said Section 15, a distance of 1,380.07 feet to a channel bar at the NW corner of the said 1/4-1/4 section; thence S 46 degrees 10 minutes 38 seconds E, a distance of 69.92 feet to a 1/2" rebar at the POINT OF BEGINNING; thence S 89 degrees 43 minutes 40 seconds E, a distance of 664.23 feet to a 1/2" rebar; thence S 00 degrees 12 minutes 15 seconds W, a distance of 550.01 feet to a 1/2" rebar; thence N 89 degrees 49 minutes 37 seconds W, a

1 distance of 664.33 feet to a 1/2" rebar; thence N 00 degrees  
2 12 minutes 50 seconds E, a distance of 551.16 feet to the  
3 POINT OF BEGINNING.

4 Section 2. In accordance with Section 11-42-6(b) of  
5 the Code of Alabama 1975, a map showing what territory is  
6 proposed to be annexed to the City of Trussville is on file in  
7 the office of the Judge of Probate in Jefferson County and St.  
8 Clair County, Alabama, and the map is open to the inspection  
9 of the public.

10 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the  
11 first day of the third month following its passage and  
12 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
