8 SYNOPSIS: This bill would authorize a local board of  
9 education to use any available facility for career  
10 technical classes upon a finding that the available  
11 facility is better suited than those currently  
12 being used.

14 A BILL  
15 TO BE ENTITLED  
16 AN ACT

18 Relating to public high schools; to authorize a  
19 local board of education to use any available facility for  
20 career technical classes upon a finding by the board that the  
21 available facility is better suited than those currently being  
22 used.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

24 Section 1. (a) Any provision of the State Building  
25 Code, as adopted by the Alabama Building Commission, or other  
26 applicable state or local building code to the contrary  
27 notwithstanding, a local board of education may use any

1 available facility for conducting career technical classes  
2 upon a finding by the board that the available facility is  
3 better suited for career technical classroom instruction than  
4 the facilities then being used.

5 (b) A determination of whether an available facility  
6 is better suited for career technical classroom instruction  
7 shall be based on the type of instruction to be provided and  
8 not whether the available facility has air conditioning.

9 Section 2. This act shall become effective  
10 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
11 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
