Section 2. In accordance with Section 11-42-6(b) of the Code of Alabama 1975, a map showing what territory is proposed to be annexed to the City of Gulf Shores is on file in the office of the Judge of Probate in Baldwin County, Alabama, and the map is open to the inspection of the public.

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Section 3. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
