24	Section 1. The following words shall have the

26	(1) AMENDMENT 373. The amendment to the Constitution
27	of Alabama 1901, that was proposed by Act 6, H. 170, 1978

Second Special Session, now appearing as Section 217 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended.

(2) CITY TAX. The ad valorem tax authorized in the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, and levied and collected on taxable property in the City Hueytown, Alabama, was originally levied at the rate of 5 mills on each one thousand dollars of assessed value and, presently levied at the rate of 10 mills on each thousand dollars of assessed value.

Section 2. The City of Hueytown, Alabama, presently levies and collects the city tax at a rate of ten dollars (\$10) on each one thousand dollars (10 mills on each thousand dollars) of assessed value. Pursuant to a resolution adopted by the City Council of the City of Hueytown, Alabama, in accordance with Amendment 373, the City of Hueytown, Alabama, proposes to increase by 10 mills the rate at which it may levy and collect the city tax to a maximum rate, for any tax year, which is equal to twenty dollars (\$20) on each thousand dollars (\$1,000) (20 mills on each thousand dollars) of assessed value.

Section 3. Pursuant to subsection (f) of Amendment 373, the City Council of the City of Hueytown, Alabama, may increase the rate at which the City of Hueytown, Alabama, levies and collects the city tax to a maximum rate for any tax year which is equal to twenty dollars (\$20) on each one thousand dollars (\$1,000) (20 mills on each thousand dollars) of assessed value, the increase of 10 mills on each dollar of

assessed value to be used as follows: The net proceeds related 1 to the 10 mills shall be used for general municipal purposes. 2 Section 4. The increase in the rate at which the 3 city tax may be levied and collected pursuant to this act is 4 5 subject to the approval of a majority of the qualified electors residing in the City of Hueytown, Alabama, who vote 7 on the proposed increase at a special election called and held for that purpose pursuant to subsection (f) of Amendment 373. 8 Section 5. This act shall become effective 9 10 immediately following its passage and approval by the

Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.

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
