4 PARTICIPATE IN PROGRAMS TO RAISE AWARENESS AND ACT TO PROTECT
5 CHILDREN FROM SEXUAL ABUSE.

7 WHEREAS, the Alabama Alliance of YMCAs is committed
8 to position the YMCA as the leading organization in child
9 sexual abuse prevention, training, and education; and

10 WHEREAS, in 2017, child abuse reports involved 7.5
11 million children in the United States; and

12 WHEREAS, the YMCA Guardians for Child Protection is
13 a group of YMCA CEOs committed to activating the Power of the
14 Y Movement, and other youth serving organizations, to engage
15 communities, improve internal operations, and advance policy
16 and environmental change to protect children from sexual
17 abuse; and

18 WHEREAS, the safety and well-being of children in
19 the care of a YMCA has always been and always will be a top
20 priority of the Alabama Alliance of YMCAs; now therefore,

21 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
22 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That all YMCAs in Alabama are
23 encouraged to participate in Five Days of Action and other
24 programs to raise awareness and inspire adults to take action
25 to protect children from sexual abuse.
