4	THAT ATTACKING A HEALTH CARE WORKER IS A FELONY.

6	WHEREAS, the people of Alabama's health care needs
7	are served by over 100,000 licensed nurses in a wide array of
8	clinical settings and levels of criticality; and
9	WHEREAS, nurses of all specialities have been cited
10	through Gallop polls as the Most Trusted Professionals for 17
11	consecutive years; and
12	WHEREAS, nurses are not only the largest workforce
13	in health care, but also devote more time to direct patient
14	care than any other health care professional; and
15	WHEREAS, both national and state data present an
16	upward trend in violence and incivility against nurses and
17	other health care workers in clinical settings; and
18	WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of patients for
19	health care providers and nurses to be able to perform their
20	duties in a safe and caring environment; and
21	WHEREAS, the Alabama Legislature passed into law,
22	Act 2006-565, found at Section 13A-6-21, Code of Alabama 1975
23	which includes an assault against a health care worker as an

assault in the second degree under statutorily prescribed

1	WHEREAS, according to a survey by the Alabama State			
2	Nurses Association of over 1,000 licensed Alabama nurses, 88			
3	percent responded that they or a close coworker had			
4	experienced violent behavior in their practice; and			
5	WHEREAS, in the same survey more than half reported			
6	that they did not know that attacking a nurse or health care			
7	worker in a clinical setting was now a felony; and			
8	WHEREAS, over 91 percent of the survey respondents			
9	indicated that it was extremely important that laws protecting			
10	nurses in clinical settings be known, upheld, and			
11	strengthened; now therefore,			
12	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH			
13	HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That a written notice of the felony			
14	status of attacking a nurse or a health care worker in certain			
15	practice settings should be posted in patient waiting areas			
16	across the State of Alabama in accordance with Section			
17	13A-6-21, Code of Alabama 1975; the Alabama State Nurses			
18	Association will design a poster that may be utilized by			
19	health care practitioners and health care facilities providing			
20	notice of Section 13A-6-21, Code of Alabama 1975.			
21	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Legislature			
22	acknowledges the extraordinary work of Alabama nurses, health			
23	care workers, and institutions in providing healing and			

life-saving care to the people of Alabama.
