4 THE TORNADO VICTIMS IN LEE COUNTY.

6 WHEREAS, it is with profound sorrow that we note the
7 deaths, on March 3, 2019, of those who lost their lives in the
8 EF4 tornado which caused much devastation in Lee County; and

9 WHEREAS, the victims ranged in age from six to 89
10 and are identified as: Jonathan Marquez Bowen, Vicki Braswell,
11 Sheila Creech, David Dean, Irma Gomez-Moran, Marshall Lynn
12 Grimes, Armondo (AJ) Hernandez, Emmanuel Jones, Jimmy Lee
13 Jones, Mary Louise Jones, Mamie Roberts Koon, Charlotte Ann
14 Miller, Ryan Pence, Maggie Delight Robinson, Raymond Robinson,
15 Jr., Tresia Robinson, Eric Jamal Stenson, Florel Tate Stenson,
16 Henry Lewis Stenson, James Henry Tate, Taylor Thornton, Mykala
17 Waldon, and Felicia Woodall; seven of the 23 victims were from
18 the same family; and

19 WHEREAS, although these individuals' presence will
20 be greatly missed, the memories of them will be cherished in
21 the hearts of all who knew and loved them; now therefore,

22 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
23 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the deaths of the 23 victims
24 of the tornado in Lee County are recorded with deep sadness,
25 and this resolution is offered in tribute to their lives and

1 with heartfelt sympathy to their families, whose grief is
2 shared by many.
