8 CELEBRATING THE MCGILL-TOOLEN 2019 BASEBALL
9 CHAMPIONS.

11 WHEREAS, the McGill-Toolen Catholic High School
12 Varsity Baseball Team won the Class 7A Alabama Baseball
13 Championship on May 18, 2019 - its first state baseball
14 championship in the school's 111-year history; and

15 WHEREAS, the McGill-Toolen Yellow Jackets defeated
16 the Bob Jones High School Patriots of Madison County, Alabama,
17 in a three-game series; and

18 WHEREAS, McGill-Toolen won the first game by a score
19 of 8-6 at Paterson Field in Montgomery, Alabama; Senior
20 Chandler Best pitched the entire game, allowing nine hits and
21 striking out seven batters; best walked two batters and
22 allowed three earned runs in the game; and

23 WHEREAS, the leading Yellow Jackets hitters in game
24 one were Michael Ellis, Chandler Best, and Jacob Huff, who
25 each had two hits; Spencer Hadley was three for four, with two
26 doubles and four RBI's (runs batted in); and

1 WHEREAS, McGill-Toolen lost the second game by a
2 score of 11-7 at Riverwalk Stadium in Montgomery; the Patroits
3 scored runs late in the game to win it; Yellow Jacket Michael
4 Ellis hit a solo home run and a double; Vinny Martino had two
5 hits and two RBI's, and Matthew Glover had a hit and two
6 RBI's; Spencer Hadley also two RBI's in game two; and

7 WHEREAS, the Yellow Jackets won the third game by a
8 score of 7-6 at Riverwalk Stadium in Montgomery; with a 5-4
9 lead in the top of the sixth inning, Nathan LaRue hit the ball
10 to center field, allowing Jennings Clayton and Michael Ellis
11 to score for the Yellow Jackets; the Patriots scored two more
12 runs on a homer; and

13 WHEREAS, the Yellow Jackets did not score in the top
14 of the 7th inning, but returned the favor by playing excellent
15 defense in the final inning; the Patriots' lead-off batter hit
16 a line drive to Shortstop Matthew Glover, who made an
17 outstanding diving play that resulted in the first out of the
18 inning; the next two batters hit singles to put runners on
19 first and second base; pitcher Nathan LaRue caught the next
20 batter's line drive and created a double play when he threw
21 the ball to Chandler Best at first base to end the game; and

22 WHEREAS, members of McGill-Toolen's baseball team,

3 WHEREAS, the team's coaches are Tim Becker, Head
4 Coach; Brandon Sage, Assistant Coach; Tommy Walker, Assistant
5 Coach; Ryan Hall, Assistant Coach; and Dalton Becker,
6 Assistant Coach; and

7 WHEREAS, in addition to winning the Class 7A Alabama
8 State High School Baseball Championship McGill-Toolen ended
9 the baseball season with a 32-8 record - a record number of
10 wins for the school in a season; now therefore,

11 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
12 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That Representative Adline C.
13 Clark of Alabama's 97th legislative district offers her
