9 BASKETBALL.

11 WHEREAS, we take great pride and special pleasure in
12 honoring Annie Hughes on being named 2019 Miss Basketball
13 during the Alabama Sports Writers Association Player of the
14 Year Banquet, presented by ALFA, in Montgomery; and

15 WHEREAS, the Pisgah High School senior was selected
16 the state's top player by AL.com and Gatorade; Hughes, a
17 5-foot-10 Auburn signee, averaged 21.4 points, 7.0 rebounds,
18 4.2 assists and 3.5 steals while helping Pisgah High School
19 repeat as Class 3A State Champion; and

20 WHEREAS, Annie Hughes was named state tournament MVP
21 following the Eagles' championship game victories over
22 Montgomery Academy in 2019 and Lauderdale County in 2018; and

23 WHEREAS, Miss Hughes is the first player from a
24 school in classification smaller than 5A to win Miss
25 Basketball since 2011; Miss Hughes is the first Jackson County
26 player to win in the 32-year history of the award; and

1 WHEREAS, Annie Hughes is rated three stars and the
2 Number 27 point guard in the nation by ESPN; now therefore,
