20	Relating to the Alabama Small Business Commission;
21	to amend Section 41-29-240, Code of Alabama 1975, to further
22	provide for the appointment of members of the commission; and
23	to require an annual report to the Lieutenant Governor.
24	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
25	Section 1. Section 41-29-240, Code of Alabama 1975,
26	is amended to read as follows:
27	" \$41-29-240

"(a) The Alabama Small Business Commission is
created as part of the Office of Small Business Advocacy.

- "(b) The commission shall have the following duties:
- "(1) Formulate policies encouraging innovation of small business in the state.
 - "(2) Discuss issues critical to the economic growth of small, independent businesses and their interests that will encourage the formation of and foster the growth of small businesses in the state.
 - "(3) Advise the Department of Commerce in formulating and promoting policies relating to small businesses.
 - "(4) Act as an advocate for small businesses and the entrepreneurs who work to create opportunities for new small businesses and sustain those that are already in existence.
 - "(5) Promote policies to assist new business start-ups and expansion of existing businesses.
 - "(c) The commission shall be chaired by an appointee of the <u>Lieutenant</u> Governor, who shall be a voting member. The Director of the Business Development Division shall be responsible for the administrative functions of the commission including, but not limited to, the organization of meetings, preparing the annual reports, and other items as needed by the commission. The commission shall be composed of the following members who shall be appointed by the <u>Lieutenant Governor and</u> shall serve a term of two years with the option of being

1	reappointed to one additional term by their appointing
2	authority:
3	"(1) One member from each of the congressional
4	districts of the state appointed by the Governor.
5	"(2) One member appointed by the Governor from a
6	list of three names submitted by the Alabama Homebuilders
7	Association.
8	"(3) One member appointed by the Governor from a
9	list of three names submitted by the Alabama Retail
10	Association.
11	"(4) One member appointed by the Governor from a
12	list of three names submitted by the Alabama Bankers
13	Association.
14	"(5) One member appointed by the Governor from a
15	list of three names submitted by the Medical Association of
16	Alabama.
17	"(6) One member appointed by the Governor from a
18	list of three names submitted by the Alabama Farmers
19	Federation.
20	"(7) One member appointed by the Governor from a
21	list of three names submitted by the Alabama Trucking
22	Association.
23	"(8) One member appointed by the Governor from a
24	list of three names submitted by the Alabama Association of
25	General Contractors.

1	"(9) One member appointed by the Governor from a
2	list of three names submitted by the Alabama Automobile
3	Dealers Association.
4	"(10) One member appointed by the Governor from the
5	manufacturing sector.
6	"(11) One member appointed by the Lieutenant
7	Governor from a list of three names submitted by the Alabama
8	Forestry Association.
9	"(12) One at-large member appointed by the
10	Lieutenant Governor .
11	"(13) One member appointed by the Speaker of the
12	House of Representatives from the service, hospitality, and
13	tourism sector.
14	"(14) One member of the House of Representatives
15	appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
16	"(15) One member of the manufacturing sector
17	appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate.
18	"(16) One member of the Senate appointed by the
19	President Pro Tempore of the Senate.
20	"(d) To the extent possible, the commission members
21	shall be small business owners representing businesses with 50
22	or fewer employees.
23	"(e) The commission shall prepare and submit an
24	annual report to the <u>Lieutenant</u> Governor no later than
25	December 31 of each year."

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
