Section 1. (a) A local fire district shall not be
authorized to assess any type of fees or dues upon forest land
that is treated as timber land for ad valorem tax purposes.

(b) The authority and responsibility for the control and coordination of fire prevention, fire protection and fire fighting services on land treated as timber land for ad valorem tax purposes shall be under the jurisdiction of the Alabama Forestry Commission.

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
