BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
Section 1. Any provision of Chapter 64, Title 16, of
the Code of Alabama 1975, to the contrary notwithstanding, the
Board of Trustees of Alabama State University may extend
resident tuition rates to certain qualified nonresident

students from Florida, Georgia, Mississippi, and Tennessee.
The board shall adopt a policy to provide for the
qualifications of students and the implementation of this
section.

5 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 6 first day of the third month following its passage and 7 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
