6 ENROLLED, An Act,

7 Relating to the City of Union Springs in Bullock
8 County; authorizing the sale of certain alcoholic beverages in
9 the city on Sundays under certain conditions; and to repeal
10 Act 2018-191 of the 2018 Regular Session.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

12 Section 1. This act applies only in the City of
13 Union Springs in Bullock County.

14 Section 2. The sale of alcoholic beverages after
15 1:00 p.m. on Sundays may be authorized by the city council
16 within the corporate limits of the City of Union Springs as
17 provided in this act. The city council, by ordinance, may
18 regulate and permit the sale and consumption of alcoholic
19 beverages on Sunday after 1:00 p.m. as determined by the city
20 council by properly licensed retail licensees of the Alcoholic
21 Beverage Control Board. Pursuant to this authority, the city
22 council may regulate which retail licensees may sell alcoholic
23 beverages on Sunday, whether the sale may be for off-premises
24 consumption, and any other aspect of the Sunday sale of
25 alcoholic beverages.

1 Section 3. Act 2018-191 of the 2018 Regular Session,
2 now appearing as Section 45-6A-80, Code of Alabama 1975, is
3 repealed.

4 Section 4. This act shall become effective
5 immediately following its passage and approval by the
6 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
