Act 2018-191 of the 2018 Regular Session, 5 now appearing as Section 45-6A-80, Code of Alabama 1975, is 6 7 repealed. Section 4. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the 9

Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
