Section 1. Sections 34-17-5 and 34-17-25 of the Code
of Alabama 1975, are amended to read as follows:

"(1) That the holder of a certificate of registration is practicing in violation of the provisions of this chapter or the rules and regulations of the board;.

"(3) That the holder of a certificate is impersonating a landscape architect or former landscape architect of the same or similar name, or is practicing under an assumed, fictitious, or corporate name;

23 "(4) That the holder of a certificate has aided or 24 abetted in the practice of landscape architecture any person 25 not authorized to practice landscape architecture under the 26 provisions of this chapter;.

1 "(5) That, in the practice of landscape 2 architecture, the holder of a certificate has been found quilty of fraud or deceit 7. 3 "(6) That, in the practice of landscape 4 5 architecture, the holder of a certificate has been found quilty of negligence or willful misconduct;. 6 7 "(7) That the holder of a certificate has been found 8 quilty of gross incompetence; or. "(8) That the holder of a certificate has affixed 9 10 his or her signature to plans, drawings, specifications, or other instruments of service which have not been prepared by 11 him or her or under his or her immediate and responsible 12 13 direction or has permitted his or her name to be used for the 14 purpose of assisting any person, not a landscape architect, to 15 evade the provisions of this chapter. "(b) For violations of the preceding subsection, or 16 17 for violations of the provisions of this chapter, or for 18 violations of board rules and regulations, the board shall 19 have the following disciplinary powers: 20 "(1) To reprimand a board licensee; 21 "(2) To levy an administrative fine against a licensee of the board not to exceed \$250 two thousand five 22 hundr<u>ed dollars (\$2,500)</u> per violation;. 23 24 "(3) To refuse to issue a certificate to an 25 applicant of the board; "(4) To suspend a licensee's certificate for a 26 27 definite period of time; or.
