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4 ENROLLED, An Act,

5 To amend Section 9-11-307, Code of Alabama 1975,
6 relating to penalties for violating laws or rules adopted by
7 the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources relating
8 to wildlife management areas; to classify the offense as a
9 Class C misdemeanor and update the fines and sentencing
10 ranges; and in connection therewith to have as its purpose or
11 effect the requirement of a new or increased expenditure of
12 local funds within the meaning of Amendment 621 of the
13 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section
14 111.05 of the Official ReCompilation of the Constitution of
15 Alabama of 1901, as amended.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

17 Section 1. Section 9-11-307, Code of Alabama 1975,
18 is amended to read as follows:

19 "§9-11-307.

20 "Any person violating ~~any of the provisions of this~~
21 article or any rule ~~or regulation promulgated~~ adopted by the
22 Commissioner of the Department of Conservation and Natural
23 Resources under the authority of this article shall be guilty
24 of a Class C misdemeanor ~~and, upon conviction, shall be fined~~
25 ~~not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$100.00 or imprisoned for~~

1 ~~not less than 30 days nor more than 12 months, or both,~~
2 punishable as provided by law, except that the minimum fine
3 shall not be less than one hundred dollars (\$100)."

4 Section 2. Although this bill would have as its
5 purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased
6 expenditure of local funds, the bill is excluded from further
7 requirements and application under Amendment 621, now
8 appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of
9 the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, because the
10 bill defines a new crime or amends the definition of an
11 existing crime.

12 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
13 first day of the third month following its passage and
14 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
