5 MOURNING THE DEATH OF BRYAN BARTLETT "BART" STARR

7 WHEREAS, it is with profound sorrow that we note the  
8 death of Bart Starr on May 26, 2019, at the age of 85 years;  
9 and

10 WHEREAS, the death of Mr. Starr leaves a void in the  
11 lives of his loving family, many friends, and the States of  
12 Alabama and Wisconsin; and

13 WHEREAS, he was born in Montgomery, Alabama, where  
14 he graduated from Sidney Lanier High School; he played  
15 football and graduated from The University of Alabama; and

16 WHEREAS, he became a member of the National Football  
17 League Green Bay Packers; and

18 WHEREAS, Starr, who played for the Packers from  
19 1956-1971, is the only quarterback in league history to win  
20 five championships in a decade; and

21 WHEREAS, Starr was named Most Valuable Player in  
22 Super Bowl I and Super Bowl II and earned the league's MVP  
23 Award in 1966 and inducted into the Hall of Fame in 1977; and

1           WHEREAS, while Starr excelled on the football field  
2 he also excelled off the football field as noted by his fellow  
3 football players, friends, and family; and

4           WHEREAS, Brett Favre, Aaron Rodgers, and Troy Aikman  
5 Super Bowl winning quarterbacks' common theme in expressing  
6 their thoughts upon learning of Bart Starr's death stated that  
7 he was the "most kind, thoughtful and classiest person you  
8 could ever know," and he was a friend; and

9           WHEREAS, Bart Starr's family eloquently stated that  
10 "While he may always be best known for his success as the  
11 Packers quarterback for 16 years, his true legacy will always  
12 be the most respectful manner in which he treated every person  
13 he met, his humble demeanor, and his generous spirit"; and

14           WHEREAS, his survivors include his beloved wife,  
15 Cherry; son, Bart Starr, Jr.; and three granddaughters; and

16           WHEREAS, although his presence will be greatly  
17 missed, his memory will be cherished in the hearts of all who  
18 knew and loved him; now, therefore,

19           BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH  
20 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the death of Bart Starr is  
21 recorded with deep sadness, and this resolution is offered in  
22 highest tribute to his life, along with heartfelt sympathy to  
23 his grieving family.
