11	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
12	HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That there is recreated the Joint
13	Legislative Committee to Study Self-Driving Vehicles.
14	(a) The committee shall be composed of the following
15	members:
16	(1) Five members of the Alabama Senate appointed by
17	the Lieutenant Governor.
18	(2) Five members of the Alabama House of
19	Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House of

21	(b) The appointing authorities shall coordinate
22	their appointments to assure that committee membership is

25	(c) The goals of the committee are to study all
26	aspects of self-driving vehicles, including specifically, the
27	issues of public safety and state and local economic impact

regarding such vehicles. The study committee shall assess the extent to which existing state legislation may impact the ability for testing of automated vehicles in the state.

- (d) The committee shall review related legislation as provided in subsection (h) and report its findings to the Speaker of the House and the Lieutenant Governor. The study committee may engage with key industry stakeholders and other experts in the development of its findings.
- (e) At its first meeting, to be called by the Lieutenant Governor, the committee members shall elect a chair and vice chair.
- (f) Upon request of the chair of the committee, the Secretary of the Senate and Clerk of the House of Representatives shall provide necessary clerical assistance for the work of the committee.
- (g) Each member of the committee shall be entitled to his or her regular legislative compensation, per diem, and travel expenses for each day he or she attends a meeting of the committee in accordance with Amendment 871 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901.
- (h) Any bill authorizing, prohibiting, or regulating in any manner the use of self-driving or autonomous vehicles shall be referred to this committee for review and comment prior to being placed on a standing committee agenda in either house.
- (i) The committee shall stand dissolved on the last legislative day of the 2022 Regular Session.
