22 On page 32, after line 17, insert a new Section 13
23 as follows and renumber the remaining section accordingly:

24 (a) Nothing in the Physical Therapy Licensure
25 Compact shall be interpreted to modify, amend, repeal, or
26 supersede any state criminal or civil liability law.

1 (b) The Physical Therapy Licensure Compact only
2 applies to those parties that voluntarily agree to participate
3 in the compact.

4 (c) In the event the Physical Therapy Compact
5 Commission adopts rules to coordinate the implementation and
6 administration of the Physical Therapy Licensure Compact that
7 conflict with Alabama law, Alabama law shall supersede those
8 rules, and the Alabama state courts shall retain sole
9 jurisdiction to determine any conflict.

10 (d) Alabama state courts shall retain sole
11 jurisdiction to determine if provisions of the Physical
12 Therapy Licensure Compact are in conflict with state laws or
13 the Constitution of Alabama of 1901.
