| 25 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:                  |

Section 1. Section 9 of Act 2019-394, the General Fund Appropriations act for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020, is hereby amended as follows:

"Section 9. In addition to appropriations herein made, all gifts, grants, insurance proceeds, contributions, or entitlements, in excess of the amount carried in this act, including grants by the Congress of the United States, municipalities or counties, to any department, division, board, bureau, commission, agency, institution, office or officer of the State of Alabama are hereby appropriated and, in the event the same are recurring, are reappropriated to such department, division, board, bureau, commission, agency, institution, office or officer to be used only for the purpose or purposes for which the grant or contribution was or shall be made. Provided, however, any expenditure made from any direct stimulus funding provided by the Congress of the United States to the State of Alabama from the Coronavirus Relief Fund of the Coronavirus, Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act (P.L. 116-136) or any other direct stimulus funding provided by Congress to the State of Alabama for expenditures related to the coronavirus pandemic, and not directly related to an existing program or function, must be approved by a majority of the Governor, and the Chairmen of the House Ways and Means - General Fund Committee, and the Senate Finance and Taxation - General Fund Committee prior to expenditure. Further, all state, county, municipal, and educational entities are authorized to disburse such sums as

deemed necessary by mutual agreement among said entities and 1 the State of Alabama, and the Department of Examiners of 2 3 Public Accounts to partially defray the cost of auditing services performed by said agency. All such sums are hereby 4 appropriated and reappropriated if necessary to the Department 5 of Examiners of Public Accounts for audit services, to be 6 7 expended through the fund established by Section 41-5A-2441-5A-22, Code of Alabama 1975." 8 Section 2. This act shall become effective 9 10 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or upon its otherwise becoming law. 11
