8 SYNOPSIS: This bill makes a supplemental appropriation
9 from the Education Trust Fund to the State
10 Department of Education in the amount of
11 \$14,085,735 for the fiscal year ending September
12 30, 2020; makes a supplemental appropriation from
13 the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama Community
14 College System in the amount of \$501,943 for the
15 fiscal year ending September 30, 2020; makes a
16 supplemental appropriation from the Education Trust
17 Fund to the Marine Environmental Sciences
18 Consortium in the amount of \$1,000,000 for the
19 fiscal year ending September 30, 2020; makes a
20 supplemental appropriation from the Education Trust
21 Fund to Alabama State University in the amount of
22 \$400,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30,
23 2020; makes a supplemental appropriation from the
24 Education Trust Fund to the Alabama Department of

9 Technology and Engineering; to amend language in Section 3A of
10 Act 2019-403 for the Examiner of Public Accounts; and to
11 revise the repayment dates for certain withdrawals from the
12 Budget Stabilization Fund.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

14 Section 1. In addition to all other appropriations
15 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
16 \$14,085,735 from the Education Trust Fund to the State
17 Department of Education for the fiscal year ending September
18 30, 2020. Of this appropriation, \$9,835,735 shall be expended
19 for expansion of the science of reading training in support of
20 initial implementations of the Literacy Act; \$2,700,000 shall
21 be expended for additional regional math coaches and trainers
22 to expand early mathematics improvement efforts and AMSTI,
23 NUMBERS, and OGAP training opportunities; \$250,000 shall be
24 expended to be paired with existing resources of the
25 Department to continue the provision of one school safety
26 liaison per ALEA region to assist schools across the state;
27 \$1,000,000 shall be expended for a marketing campaign for

1 teachers; and \$300,000 shall be expended for teacher and
2 parent online teaching assistance grants.

3 Section 2. In addition to all other appropriations
4 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
5 \$501,943 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama
6 Community College System for the fiscal year ending September
7 30, 2020.

8 Section 3. In addition to all other appropriations
9 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
10 \$1,000,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Marine
11 Environmental Sciences Consortium for the fiscal year ending
12 September 30, 2020 for Wetlab relocation and renovation.

13 Section 4. In addition to all other appropriations
14 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
15 \$1,000,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama
16 Department of Commerce for the fiscal year ending September
17 30, 2020 to assist with the expansion of the Lockheed Martin
18 Corporation training facility.

19 Section 5. In addition to all other appropriations
20 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
21 \$400,000 from the Education Trust Fund to Alabama State
22 University for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 for
23 one-time repair expenses for the forensics lab.

24 Section 6. In addition to all other appropriations
25 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
26 \$144,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama Fire

1 College for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 for
2 one-time expenses for an audio/visual presentation system.

3 Section 7. In addition to all other appropriations
4 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
5 \$6,878,778 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama
6 Institute for the Deaf and Blind for the fiscal year ending
7 September 30, 2020 to assist in the construction and expansion
8 of regional centers.

9 Section 8. In addition to all other appropriations
10 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
11 \$500,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the University of
12 South Alabama for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020
13 for one-time expenses for Children and Women's Learning
14 Hospital expansion.

15 Section 9. In addition to all other appropriations
16 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
17 \$2,170,265 from the Education Trust Fund to the Education
18 Trust Fund Advancement and Technology Fund for the fiscal year
19 ending September 30, 2020 to be allocated in accordance with
20 Section 29-9-4, Code of Alabama 1975.

21 Section 10. In addition to all other appropriations
22 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
23 \$50,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama
24 Department of Archives and History for the fiscal year ending
25 September 30, 2020.

26 Section 11. In addition to all other appropriations
27 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated

1 \$2,000,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Department of
2 Early Childhood Education for the fiscal year ending September
3 30, 2020.

4 Section 12. In addition to all other appropriations
5 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
6 \$2,500,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama
7 Supercomputer Authority for the fiscal year ending September
8 30, 2020 for cybersecurity and IT support for K-12 schools in
9 consultation with ALETS, of which \$1,000,000 shall be expended
10 for professional development for all education employees in
11 the form of software-based cybersecurity training focused on
12 improving digital security.

13 Section 13. In addition to all other appropriations
14 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
15 \$35,000 from the Education Trust Fund to Miles College for the
16 fiscal year ending September 30, 2020

17 Section 14. In addition to all other appropriations
18 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
19 \$35,000 from the Education Trust Fund to Stillman College for
20 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020.

21 Section 15. In addition to all other appropriations
22 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
23 \$35,000 from the Education Trust Fund to Wallace Community
24 College-Selma for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020
25 for Excellence in Education to Employment Pipeline.

26 Section 16. In addition to all other appropriations
27 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated

1 \$280,000 from the Education Trust Fund to Athens State
2 University for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 for
3 virtual lab kits and student virtual interfaces and cloud
4 delivery expenses.

5 Section 17. In addition to all other appropriations
6 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
7 \$175,000 from the Education Trust Fund to Troy University for
8 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 for the Sign
9 Language Interpretive Center.

10 Section 18. In addition to all other appropriations
11 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
12 \$240,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama
13 Commission on Higher Education for the fiscal year ending
14 September 30, 2020, of which \$120,000 shall be for the City of
15 Decatur and \$120,000 shall be for Marengo County to establish
16 the Best and Brightest STEM Pilot Program for the purpose of
17 paying the student loan debt of recent STEM graduates that
18 relocate to the City of Decatur and Marengo County. Applicants
19 must have a STEM degree from an Alabama four-year institution
20 of higher education and cannot be a resident of the subject
21 county at the time of application. The duration of the pilot
22 program shall be no more than five years and the amount
23 available per graduate shall be \$3,000 annually.

24 Section 19. All funds appropriated in this act not
25 expended in the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 shall
26 not revert but shall be carried forward for the purpose
27 appropriated.

1 Section 20. The appropriation made within the Fine
2 Arts Program of the Alabama State Council on the Arts in
3 Section 3B of Act 2019-403 is amended to read as follows: "Of
4 the above appropriation, \$875,000 shall be expended for the
5 Alabama Center for the Arts, of which \$75,000 shall be
6 expended for Urban Art; \$75,000 shall be expended for the Arts
7 Hall of Fame; and \$200,000 shall be expended for the Alabama
8 Center for the Arts Foundation."

9 Section 21. Notwithstanding any other provision of
10 law to the contrary, any of the appropriation made in Section
11 3B of Act 2019-403 to the Alabama School of Cyber Technology
12 and Engineering which remains unexpended on September 30,
13 2020, shall be reappropriated to the school in the fiscal year
14 beginning October 1, 2020.

15 Section 22. Notwithstanding any other provision of
16 law to the contrary, any funds appropriated in Section 3A of
17 Act 2019-403 to the Department of Examiners of Public Accounts
18 for the evaluation and reorganization study of the State
19 Department of Education which remains unexpended on September
20 30, 2020, shall be reappropriated to the Department in the
21 fiscal year beginning October 1, 2020.

22 Section 23. Notwithstanding the provisions of
23 Sections 29-9-6, Code of Alabama 1975, during the fiscal year
24 ending September 30, 2020, temporary transfers from the Budget
25 Stabilization Fund into the Education Trust Fund to alleviate
26 cash flow problems shall be repaid within 180 days following
27 the date the funds are transferred. Notwithstanding the

1 provisions of Section 29-9-5(b), amounts withdrawn prior to
2 January 1, 2020 shall be repaid within four years.

3 Section 24. This act shall become effective
4 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
5 upon its otherwise becoming law.
