22 To make a supplemental appropriation from the State
23 General Fund for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 to
24 the District Attorneys; to amend Section 9 of Act 2019-394,
25 the General Fund Appropriations Act, regarding the
26 appropriation of grants by the Congress of the United States

1 to the State of Alabama, in excess of the amounts authorized
2 by Act 2019-394.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

4 Section 1. In addition to all other appropriations
5 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
6 \$4,500,000 from the State General Fund to the District
7 Attorneys for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020.

8 Section 2. Section 9 of Act 2019-394, the General
9 Fund Appropriations Act for the fiscal year ending September
10 30, 2020, is hereby amended as follows:

11 "Section 9. (a) In addition to appropriations herein
12 made, all gifts, grants, insurance proceeds, contributions, or
13 entitlements, in excess of the amount carried in this act,
14 including grants by the Congress of the United States,
15 municipalities or counties, to any department, division,
16 board, bureau, commission, agency, institution, office or
17 officer of the State of Alabama are hereby appropriated and,
18 in the event the same are recurring, are reappropriated to
19 such department, division, board, bureau, commission, agency,
20 institution, office or officer to be used only for the purpose
21 or purposes for which the grant or contribution was or shall
22 be made. Further, all state, county, municipal, and
23 educational entities are authorized to disburse such sums as
24 deemed necessary by mutual agreement among said entities and
25 the State of Alabama, and the Department of Examiners of
26 Public Accounts to partially defray the cost of auditing
27 services performed by said agency. All such sums are hereby

1 appropriated and reappropriated if necessary to the Department
2 of Examiners of Public Accounts for audit services, to be
3 expended through the fund established by Section ~~41-5A-24~~
4 41-5A-22, Code of Alabama 1975."

5 (b) Provided, however, this section shall not apply
6 to the state Coronavirus Relief Fund amounts provided by the
7 Congress of the United States to the State of Alabama from the
8 Coronavirus, Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act
9 (P.L. 116-136), except for an amount not to exceed
10 \$100,000,000 for expenditures related to the coronavirus
11 pandemic. This section shall also not apply to any additional
12 federal stimulus funds provided to the state to offset revenue
13 losses or for purposes directly related to the coronavirus
14 pandemic, other than additional funds provided for existing
15 federal programs.

16 Section 3. This act shall become effective
17 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
18 upon its otherwise becoming law.
