Ladies and Gentlemen:

I received House Bill 189 and believe that the bill needs to be revised to make a technical correction that clarifies legislative intent regarding certain appropriations.

For this reason, I am returning to you, the body in which it originated, House Bill 189 without my signature and with the below executive amendment:

EXECUTIVE AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 189

Please amend House Bill 189 on page 2, on line 13, by deleting "Miles College" and replacing with the following language:

"Alabama A and M University, Board of Trustees-Miles College Consortium"

Please amend House Bill 189 on page 2, on lines 15 and 16, by deleting "Stillman College" and replacing with the following language:

"West Alabama, University of, Board of Trustees-Stillman College".

Please amend House Bill 189 on page 6, on line 22, by deleting "Miles College" and replacing with the following language:

"Alabama A and M University, Board of Trustees-Miles College Consortium".

Please amend House Bill 189 on page 7, on line 1, by deleting "Stillman College" and replacing with the following language:

"West Alabama, University of, Board of Trustees-Stillman College".

Adoption of the above proposed executive amendment will remove my objection to this bill.
