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6 AN ACT

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To make a supplemental appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to the State Department of Education in the amount of \$14,085,735 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020; to make a supplemental appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama Community College System in the amount of \$501,943 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020; to make a supplemental appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to the Marine Environmental Sciences Consortium in the amount of \$1,000,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020; to make a supplemental appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to Alabama State University in the amount of \$400,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020; to make a supplemental appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama Department of Commerce in the amount of \$1,000,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020; to make a supplemental appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to the Fire College in the amount of \$144,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020; to make a supplemental appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama Institute for the Deaf

and Blind in the amount of \$6,878,778 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020; to make a supplemental appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to the University of South Alabama in the amount of \$500,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020; to make a supplemental appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama Department of Archives and History in the amount of \$50,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020; to make a supplemental appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to the Education Trust Fund Advancement and Technology Fund in the amount of \$7,470,265 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020; to amend language in Section 3B of Act 2019-403 for the Alabama State Council on the Arts; to amend language in Section 3B of Act 2019-403 for the Alabama School of Cyber Technology and Engineering; to amend language in Section 3A of Act 2019-403 for the Examiner of Public Accounts; and to revise the repayment date for temporary transfers from the Budget Stabilization Fund for cash flow purposes for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 only.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

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Section 1. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$14,085,735 from the Education Trust Fund to the State Department of Education for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020. Of this appropriation, \$9,835,735 shall be expended for expansion of the science of reading training in support of initial implementations of the Literacy Act; \$2,700,000 shall

be expended for additional regional math coaches and trainers 1 2 to expand early mathematics improvement efforts and AMSTI, NUMBERS, and OGAP training opportunities; \$250,000 shall be 3 expended to be paired with existing resources of the 4 5 Department to continue the provision of one school safety 6 liaison per ALEA region to assist schools across the state; 7 \$1,000,000 shall be expended for a marketing campaign for teachers; and \$300,000 shall be expended for teacher and parent online teaching assistance grants.

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Section 2. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$501,943 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama Community College System for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020.

Section 3. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$1,000,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Marine Environmental Sciences Consortium for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 for Wetlab relocation and renovation.

Section 4. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$1,000,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama Department of Commerce for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 to assist with the expansion of the Lockheed Martin Corporation training facility.

Section 5. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated

\$400,000 from the Education Trust Fund to Alabama State
University for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 for
one-time repair expenses for the forensics lab.

Section 6. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$144,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama Fire College for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 for one-time expenses for an audio/visual presentation system.

Section 7. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$6,878,778 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama Institute for the Deaf and Blind for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 to assist in the construction and expansion of regional centers.

Section 8. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$500,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the University of South Alabama for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 for one-time expenses for Children and Women's Learning Hospital expansion.

Section 9. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$7,470,265 from the Education Trust Fund to the Education Trust Fund Advancement and Technology Fund for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 to be allocated in accordance with Section 29-9-4, Code of Alabama 1975.

Section 10. In addition to all other appropriations
heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated

\$50,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama

Department of Archives and History for the fiscal year ending

September 30, 2020.

Section 11. All funds appropriated in this act not expended in the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 shall not revert but shall be carried forward for the purpose appropriated.

Section 12. The appropriation made within the Fine Arts Program of the Alabama State Council on the Arts in Section 3B of Act 2019-403 is amended to read as follows: "Of the above appropriation, \$875,000 shall be expended for the Alabama Center for the Arts, of which \$75,000 shall be expended for Urban Art; \$75,000 shall be expended for the Arts Hall of Fame; and \$200,000 shall be expended for the Alabama Center for the Arts Foundation."

Section 13. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, any of the appropriation made in Section 3B of Act 2019-403 to the Alabama School of Cyber Technology and Engineering which remains unexpended on September 30, 2020, shall be reappropriated to the school in the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2020.

Section 14. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, any funds appropriated in Section 3A of Act 2019-403 to the Department of Examiners of Public Accounts for the evaluation and reorganization study of the State

Department of Education which remains unexpended on September 30, 2020, shall be reappropriated to the Department in the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2020.

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Section 15. Notwithstanding the provisions of Sections 29-9-6, Code of Alabama 1975, during the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020, temporary transfers from the Budget Stabilization Fund into the Education Trust Fund to alleviate cash flow problems shall be repaid within 180 days following the date the funds are transferred.

Section 16. This act shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or upon its otherwise becoming law.
