3 To make a supplemental appropriation from the
4 Education Trust Fund to the State Department of Education in
5 the amount of \$14,085,735 for the fiscal year ending September
6 30, 2020; to make a supplemental appropriation from the
7 Education Trust Fund to the Alabama Community College System
8 in the amount of \$501,943 for the fiscal year ending September
9 30, 2020; to make a supplemental appropriation from the
10 Education Trust Fund to the Marine Environmental Sciences
11 Consortium in the amount of \$1,000,000 for the fiscal year
12 ending September 30, 2020; to make a supplemental
13 appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to Alabama State
14 University in the amount of \$400,000 for the fiscal year
15 ending September 30, 2020; to make a supplemental
16 appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama
17 Department of Commerce in the amount of \$1,000,000 for the
18 fiscal year ending September 30, 2020; to make a supplemental
19 appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to the Fire
20 College in the amount of \$144,000 for the fiscal year ending
21 September 30, 2020; to make a supplemental appropriation from
22 the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama Institute for the Deaf
23 and Blind in the amount of \$6,878,778 for the fiscal year
24 ending September 30, 2020; to make a supplemental
25 appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to the University

1 of South Alabama in the amount of \$500,000 for the fiscal year
2 ending September 30, 2020; to make a supplemental
3 appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama
4 Department of Archives and History in the amount of \$50,000
5 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020; to make a
6 supplemental appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to
7 the Department of Early Childhood Education in the amount of
8 \$2,000,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020; to
9 make a supplemental appropriation from the Education Trust
10 Fund to the Alabama Supercomputer Authority in the amount of
11 \$2,500,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020; to
12 make a supplemental appropriation from the Education Trust
13 Fund to Alabama A and M University, Board of Trustees - Miles
14 College Consortium in the amount of \$35,000 for the fiscal
15 year ending September 30, 2020; to make a supplemental
16 appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to West Alabama,
17 University of, Board of Trustees - Stillman College in the
18 amount of \$35,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30,
19 2020; to make a supplemental appropriation from the Education
20 Trust Fund to Wallace Community Collge-Selma in the amount of
21 \$35,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020; to make
22 a supplemental appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to
23 Athens State University in the amount of \$280,000 for the
24 fiscal year ending September 30, 2020; to make a supplemental
25 appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to Troy University

1 in the amount of \$175,000 for the fiscal year ending September
2 30, 2020; to make a supplemental appropriation from the
3 Education Trust Fund to the Alabama Commission on Higher
4 Education in the amount of \$240,000 for the fiscal year ending
5 September 30, 2020; to make a supplemental appropriation from
6 the Education Trust Fund to the Education Trust Fund
7 Advancement and Technology Fund in the amount of \$2,170,265
8 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020; to amend
9 language in Section 3B of Act 2019-403 for the Alabama State
10 Council on the Arts; to amend language in Section 3B of Act
11 2019-403 for the Alabama School of Cyber Technology and
12 Engineering; to amend language in Section 3A of Act 2019-403
13 for the Examiner of Public Accounts; and to revise the
14 repayment dates for certain withdrawals from the Budget
15 Stabilization Fund.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

17 Section 1. In addition to all other appropriations
18 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
19 \$14,085,735 from the Education Trust Fund to the State
20 Department of Education for the fiscal year ending September
21 30, 2020. Of this appropriation, \$9,835,735 shall be expended
22 for expansion of the science of reading training in support of
23 initial implementations of the Literacy Act; \$2,700,000 shall
24 be expended for additional regional math coaches and trainers
25 to expand early mathematics improvement efforts and AMSTI,

1 NUMBERS, and OGAP training opportunities; \$250,000 shall be
2 expended to be paired with existing resources of the
3 Department to continue the provision of one school safety
4 liaison per ALEA region to assist schools across the state;
5 \$1,000,000 shall be expended for a marketing campaign for
6 teachers; and \$300,000 shall be expended for teacher and
7 parent online teaching assistance grants.

8 Section 2. In addition to all other appropriations
9 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
10 \$501,943 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama
11 Community College System for the fiscal year ending September
12 30, 2020.

13 Section 3. In addition to all other appropriations
14 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
15 \$1,000,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Marine
16 Environmental Sciences Consortium for the fiscal year ending
17 September 30, 2020 for Wetlab relocation and renovation.

18 Section 4. In addition to all other appropriations
19 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
20 \$1,000,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama
21 Department of Commerce for the fiscal year ending September
22 30, 2020 to assist with the expansion of the Lockheed Martin
23 Corporation training facility.

24 Section 5. In addition to all other appropriations
25 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated

1 \$400,000 from the Education Trust Fund to Alabama State
2 University for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 for
3 one-time repair expenses for the forensics lab.

4 Section 6. In addition to all other appropriations
5 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
6 \$144,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama Fire
7 College for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 for
8 one-time expenses for an audio/visual presentation system.

9 Section 7. In addition to all other appropriations
10 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
11 \$6,878,778 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama
12 Institute for the Deaf and Blind for the fiscal year ending
13 September 30, 2020 to assist in the construction and expansion
14 of regional centers.

15 Section 8. In addition to all other appropriations
16 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
17 \$500,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the University of
18 South Alabama for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020
19 for one-time expenses for Children and Women's Learning
20 Hospital expansion.

21 Section 9. In addition to all other appropriations
22 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
23 \$2,170,265 from the Education Trust Fund to the Education
24 Trust Fund Advancement and Technology Fund for the fiscal year

1 ending September 30, 2020 to be allocated in accordance with
2 Section 29-9-4, Code of Alabama 1975.

3 Section 10. In addition to all other appropriations
4 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
5 \$50,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama
6 Department of Archives and History for the fiscal year ending
7 September 30, 2020.

8 Section 11. In addition to all other appropriations
9 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
10 \$2,000,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Department of
11 Early Childhood Education for the fiscal year ending September
12 30, 2020.

13 Section 12. In addition to all other appropriations
14 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
15 \$2,500,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama
16 Supercomputer Authority for the fiscal year ending September
17 30, 2020 for cybersecurity and IT support for K-12 schools in
18 consultation with ALETS, of which \$1,000,000 shall be expended
19 for professional development for all education employees in
20 the form of software-based cybersecurity training focused on
21 improving digital security.

22 Section 13. In addition to all other appropriations
23 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
24 \$35,000 from the Education Trust Fund to ~~Miles College~~ Alabama

1 A and M University, Board of Trustees - Miles College
2 Consortium for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020

3 Section 14. In addition to all other appropriations
4 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
5 \$35,000 from the Education Trust Fund to ~~Stillman College~~ West
6 Alabama, University of, Board of Trustees - Stillman College
7 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020.

8 Section 15. In addition to all other appropriations
9 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
10 \$35,000 from the Education Trust Fund to Wallace Community
11 College-Selma for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020
12 for Excellence in Education to Employment Pipeline.

13 Section 16. In addition to all other appropriations
14 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
15 \$280,000 from the Education Trust Fund to Athens State
16 University for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 for
17 virtual lab kits and student virtual interfaces and cloud
18 delivery expenses.

19 Section 17. In addition to all other appropriations
20 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
21 \$175,000 from the Education Trust Fund to Troy University for
22 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 for the Sign
23 Language Interpretive Center.

24 Section 18. In addition to all other appropriations
25 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated

1 \$240,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama
2 Commission on Higher Education for the fiscal year ending
3 September 30, 2020, of which \$120,000 shall be for the City of
4 Decatur and \$120,000 shall be for Marengo County to establish
5 the Best and Brightest STEM Pilot Program for the purpose of
6 paying the student loan debt of recent STEM graduates that
7 relocate to the City of Decatur and Marengo County. Applicants
8 must have a STEM degree from an Alabama four-year institution
9 of higher education and cannot be a resident of the subject
10 county at the time of application. The duration of the pilot
11 program shall be no more than five years and the amount
12 available per graduate shall be \$3,000 annually.

13 Section 19. All funds appropriated in this act not
14 expended in the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 shall
15 not revert but shall be carried forward for the purpose
16 appropriated.

17 Section 20. The appropriation made within the Fine
18 Arts Program of the Alabama State Council on the Arts in
19 Section 3B of Act 2019-403 is amended to read as follows: "Of
20 the above appropriation, \$875,000 shall be expended for the
21 Alabama Center for the Arts, of which \$75,000 shall be
22 expended for Urban Art; \$75,000 shall be expended for the Arts
23 Hall of Fame; and \$200,000 shall be expended for the Alabama
24 Center for the Arts Foundation."

1 Section 21. Notwithstanding any other provision of
2 law to the contrary, any of the appropriation made in Section
3 3B of Act 2019-403 to the Alabama School of Cyber Technology
4 and Engineering which remains unexpended on September 30,
5 2020, shall be reappropriated to the school in the fiscal year
6 beginning October 1, 2020.

7 Section 22. Notwithstanding any other provision of
8 law to the contrary, any funds appropriated in Section 3A of
9 Act 2019-403 to the Department of Examiners of Public Accounts
10 for the evaluation and reorganization study of the State
11 Department of Education which remains unexpended on September
12 30, 2020, shall be reappropriated to the Department in the
13 fiscal year beginning October 1, 2020.

14 Section 23. Notwithstanding the provisions of
15 Sections 29-9-6, Code of Alabama 1975, during the fiscal year
16 ending September 30, 2020, temporary transfers from the Budget
17 Stabilization Fund into the Education Trust Fund to alleviate
18 cash flow problems shall be repaid within 180 days following
19 the date the funds are transferred. Notwithstanding the
20 provisions of Section 29-9-5(b), amounts withdrawn prior to
21 January 1, 2020 shall be repaid within four years.

22 Section 24. This act shall become effective
23 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
24 upon its otherwise becoming law.
