8 SYNOPSIS: This bill makes a supplemental appropriation
9 from the Education Trust Fund to the State
10 Department of Education in the amount of
11 \$24,950,000 for the fiscal year ending September
12 30, 2020; makes a supplemental appropriation from
13 the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama Community
14 College System in the amount of \$501,943 for the
15 fiscal year ending September 30, 2020; makes a
16 supplemental appropriation from the Education Trust
17 Fund to the Marine Environmental Sciences
18 Consortium in the amount of \$1,000,000 for the
19 fiscal year ending September 30, 2020; makes a
20 supplemental appropriation from the Education Trust
21 Fund to the Alabama Department of Commerce in the
22 amount of \$1,000,000 for the fiscal year ending
23 September 30, 2020; makes a supplemental
24 appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to the
25 Alabama Institute for the Deaf and Blind in an
26 amount of \$4,578,778 for the fiscal year ending
27 September 30, 2020; amends language in Section 3B

1 of Act 2019-403 for the Alabama State Council on
2 the Arts; and amends language in Section 3B of Act
3 2019-403 for the Alabama School of Cyber Technology
4 and Engineering.

10 To make a supplemental appropriation from the
11 Education Trust Fund to the State Department of Education in
12 the amount of \$24,950,000 for the fiscal year ending September
13 30, 2020; to make a supplemental appropriation from the
14 Education Trust Fund to the Alabama Community College System
15 in the amount of \$501,943 for the fiscal year ending September
16 30, 2020; to make a supplemental appropriation from the
17 Education Trust Fund to the Marine Environmental Sciences
18 Consortium in the amount of \$1,000,000 for the fiscal year
19 ending September 30, 2020; to make a supplemental
20 appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama
21 Department of Commerce in an amount of \$1,000,000 for the
22 fiscal year ending September 30, 2020; to make a supplemental
23 appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama
24 Institute for the Deaf and Blind in the amount of \$4,578,778
25 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020; to amend
26 language in Section 3B of Act 2019-403 for the Alabama State
27 Council on the Arts; and to amend language in Section 3B of

1 Act 2019-403 for the Alabama School of Cyber Technology and
2 Engineering.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

4 Section 1. In addition to all other appropriations
5 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
6 \$24,950,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the State
7 Department of Education for the fiscal year ending September
8 30, 2020. Of this appropriation, \$21,000,000 shall be expended
9 for expansion of the science of reading training in support of
10 initial implementations of the Literacy Act; \$2,700,000 shall
11 be expended for additional regional math coaches and trainers
12 to expand early mathematics improvement efforts and AMSTI,
13 NUMBERS, and OGAP training opportunities; \$250,000 shall be
14 expended to be paired with existing resources of the
15 Department to continue the provision of one school safety
16 liaison per ALEA region to assist schools across the state;
17 and \$1,000,000 shall be expended for a marketing campaign for
18 teachers.

19 Section 2. In addition to all other appropriations
20 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
21 \$501,943 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama
22 Community College System for the fiscal year ending September
23 30, 2020.

24 Section 3. In addition to all other appropriations
25 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
26 \$1,000,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Marine

1 Environmental Sciences Consortium for the fiscal year ending
2 September 30, 2020 for Wetlab relocation and renovation.

3 Section 4. In addition to all other appropriations
4 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
5 \$1,000,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama
6 Department of Commerce for the fiscal year ending September
7 30, 2020 to assist with the expansion of the Lockheed Martin
8 Corporation training facility.

9 Section 5. In addition to all other appropriations
10 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
11 \$4,578,778 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama
12 Institute for the Deaf and Blind for the fiscal year ending
13 September 30, 2020 to assist in the construction and expansion
14 of regional centers.

15 Section 6. The appropriation made within the Fine
16 Arts Program of the Alabama State Council on the Arts in
17 Section 3B of Act 2019-403 is amended to read as follows: "Of
18 the above appropriation, \$875,000 shall be expended for the
19 Alabama Center for the Arts, of which \$75,000 shall be
20 expended for Urban Art; \$75,000 shall be expended for the Arts
21 Hall of Fame; and \$200,000 shall be expended for the Alabama
22 Center for the Arts Foundation."

23 Section 7. Notwithstanding any other provision of
24 law to the contrary, any of the appropriation made in Section
25 3B of Act 2019-403 to the Alabama School of Cyber Technology
26 and Engineering which remains unexpended on September 30,

1 2020, shall be reappropriated to the school in the fiscal year
2 beginning October 1, 2020.

3 Section 8. This act shall become effective
4 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
5 upon its otherwise becoming law.
