13 Relating to Randolph County; to authorize the sale
14 of draft or keg beer under certain conditions.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

16 Section 1. This act shall only apply in Randolph
17 County.

18 Section 2. The Randolph County Commission, by
19 ordinance, may permit the sale of draft or keg beer by retail
20 licensees of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board for
21 on-premises consumption and for off-premises consumption. Beer
22 sold for off-premises consumption may not exceed 288 ounces
23 per customer per day which must be sealed, labeled, packaged,
24 and taxed in accordance with state and federal laws and
25 regulations. No draft or keg beer shall be sold on a Sunday
26 unless authorized by general or local law. The county
27 commission, by ordinance, may otherwise regulate the sale of

1 draft or keg beer by retail licensees of the Alcoholic
2 Beverage Control Board within the municipality.

3 Section 3. This act shall become effective
4 immediately following its passage and approval by the
5 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
