13 Relating to Sumter County; to amend Sections 1, 2,
14 and 3 of Act 2464 of the 1971 Regular Session (Acts 1971, p.
15 3929), as amended by Act 79-730, 1979 Regular Session (Acts
16 1979, p. 1299) and as last amended by Act 97-247 of the 1997
17 Regular Session (Acts 1997, p. 429), providing for the
18 issuance fee and distribution of the fee for pistol permits
19 issued by the sheriff; to increase the fee and provide further
20 for the distribution of the fee.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

22 Section 1. Sections 1, 2, and 3 of Act 2464 of the
23 1971 Regular Session (Acts 1971, p. 3929), as amended, are
24 further amended to read as follows:

25 "Section 1. In Sumter County, the fee for issuance
26 of a permit to carry a pistol in a vehicle or concealed on or
27 about the person as provided in Section 13A-11-75 of the Code

1 of Alabama 1975, shall be ~~fifteen dollars (\$15)~~ twenty dollars
2 (\$20) each year, which shall be collected by the sheriff.

3 "Section 2. ~~Eleven dollars and twenty-five cents~~
4 ~~(\$11.25)~~ Sixteen dollars and twenty-five cents (\$16.25) of
5 each fee collected under Section 1 of this act shall be
6 deposited by the Sheriff of Sumter County in any bank located
7 in Sumter County, into a fund known as the ~~"Sheriff's Fund."~~
8 Sheriff's Pistol Permit Fund. The Sheriff's Pistol Permit Fund
9 may be drawn upon by the sheriff or his or her appointed agent
10 and shall be exclusively used for law enforcement purposes in
11 the public's interest and in the discharge of the duties of
12 the sheriff's office as the sheriff determines. The Sheriff's
13 Pistol Permit Fund and the use of the fund shall not diminish
14 or take the place of any disbursement or other source of
15 income established for the sheriff or for the operation of the
16 sheriff's office.

17 "Section 3. Three dollars and seventy-five cents
18 (\$3.75) of the fee collected under Section 1 shall be ~~paid~~
19 issued by the Sheriff of Sumter County ~~into the general fund~~
20 ~~of Sumter County to be used for any purpose authorized by the~~
21 ~~county commission~~ to the Sumter County Commission, to be
22 deposited in the Sumter County Commission General Fund."

23 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
24 first day of the third month following its passage and
25 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
