4 "(b) (1) The Joppa Historical Board may accept title  
5 to the former Joppa School property owned by the Cullman  
6 County Board of Education and may hold the property for the  
7 benefit and use of the public, particularly the unincorporated  
8 community of Joppa. The Joppa Historical Board may receive  
9 state~~and,~~ local, and other governmental funding and may  
10 accept charitable donations.

11 "(2) The board may not sell or transfer ownership of  
12 the property unless approved by majority vote of the board and  
13 then by a majority vote of the qualified electors in the  
14 unincorporated community of Joppa at a referendum called by  
15 the judge of probate and held during the following general  
16 election.

17 "(c) The Joppa Historical Board may be reorganized  
18 as an unincorporated nonprofit association or other entity  
19 authorized by law by unanimous consent of the board.

20 Section 2. This act shall become effective  
21 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
22 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
