Any employee handling alcoholic beverages at the "drive-up," "walk-up," or "drive-thru" window must be 21 years 4 of age or older. 5 (b) Not later than January 1, 2021, the board shall 6 7 adopt rules to implement this section. Section 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 8 2020, following its passage and approval by the Governor, or 9
