11 To make a supplemental appropriation from the State
12 General Fund for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 to
13 the District Attorneys; to amend Section 9 of Act 2019-394,
14 the General Fund Appropriations Act, regarding the
15 appropriation of grants by the Congress of the United States
16 to the State of Alabama, in excess of the amounts authorized
17 by Act 2019-394.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

19 Section 1. In addition to all other appropriations
20 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
21 \$4,500,000 from the State General Fund to the District
22 Attorneys for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020.

23 Section 2. Section 9 of Act 2019-394, the General
24 Fund Appropriations Act for the fiscal year ending September
25 30, 2020, is hereby amended as follows:

26 "Section 9. (a) In addition to appropriations herein
27 made, all gifts, grants, insurance proceeds, contributions, or

1 entitlements, in excess of the amount carried in this act,
2 including grants by the Congress of the United States,
3 municipalities or counties, to any department, division,
4 board, bureau, commission, agency, institution, office or
5 officer of the State of Alabama are hereby appropriated and,
6 in the event the same are recurring, are reappropriated to
7 such department, division, board, bureau, commission, agency,
8 institution, office or officer to be used only for the purpose
9 or purposes for which the grant or contribution was or shall
10 be made. Further, all state, county, municipal, and
11 educational entities are authorized to disburse such sums as
12 deemed necessary by mutual agreement among said entities and
13 the State of Alabama, and the Department of Examiners of
14 Public Accounts to partially defray the cost of auditing
15 services performed by said agency. All such sums are hereby
16 appropriated and reappropriated if necessary to the Department
17 of Examiners of Public Accounts for audit services, to be
18 expended through the fund established by Section ~~41-5A-24~~
19 41-5A-22, Code of Alabama 1975."

20 (b) Provided, however, this section shall not apply
21 to the state Coronavirus Relief Fund amounts provided by the
22 Congress of the United States to the State of Alabama from the
23 Coronavirus, Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act
24 (P.L. 116-136), except for an amount not to exceed
25 \$100,000,000 for expenditures related to the coronavirus
26 pandemic. This section shall also not apply to any additional
27 federal stimulus funds provided to the state to offset revenue

1 losses or for purposes directly related to the coronavirus
2 pandemic, other than additional funds provided for existing
3 federal programs.

4 Section 3. This act shall become effective
5 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
6 upon its otherwise becoming law.
