18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:		
19	Section 1. In addition to all other appropriations		
20	heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated		
21	\$4,500,000 from the State General Fund to the District		
22	Attorneys for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020.		
23	Section 2. Section 9 of Act 2019-394, the General		
24	Fund Appropriations Act for the fiscal year ending September		
25	30, 2020, is hereby amended as follows:		
26	"Section 9. (a) In addition to appropriations herein		
27	made, all gifts, grants, insurance proceeds, contributions, or		

entitlements, in excess of the amount carried in this act, including grants by the Congress of the United States, municipalities or counties, to any department, division, board, bureau, commission, agency, institution, office or officer of the State of Alabama are hereby appropriated and, in the event the same are recurring, are reappropriated to such department, division, board, bureau, commission, agency, institution, office or officer to be used only for the purpose or purposes for which the grant or contribution was or shall be made. Further, all state, county, municipal, and educational entities are authorized to disburse such sums as deemed necessary by mutual agreement among said entities and the State of Alabama, and the Department of Examiners of Public Accounts to partially defray the cost of auditing services performed by said agency. All such sums are hereby appropriated and reappropriated if necessary to the Department of Examiners of Public Accounts for audit services, to be expended through the fund established by Section 41-5A-2441-5A-22, Code of Alabama 1975."

(b) Provided, however, this section shall not apply to the state Coronavirus Relief Fund amounts provided by the Congress of the United States to the State of Alabama from the Coronavirus, Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act (P.L. 116-136), except for an amount not to exceed \$100,000,000 for expenditures related to the coronavirus pandemic. This section shall also not apply to any additional federal stimulus funds provided to the state to offset revenue

1	losses or for purposes directly related to the coronavirus
2	pandemic, other than additional funds provided for existing
3	federal programs.
4	Section 3. This act shall become effective
5	immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
