9	established for enumerated state agencies. The
10	agencies are periodically reviewed by the Alabama
11	Sunset Committee. After the review process is

15	terminate, or continue with modification each

25	Relating to the Alabama Sunset Law; to continue the
26	existence and functioning of the Department of Insurance until
27	October 1, 2024.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

2 Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the 3 Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the Department 4 of Insurance until October 1, 2024.

5 Section 2. The existence and functioning of the 6 Department of Insurance, created and functioning pursuant to 7 Section 27-2-1, specifically, and Title 27, generally, Code of 8 Alabama 1975, is continued until October 1, 2024, and those 9 code sections are expressly preserved.

10 Section 3. The Legislature concurs in the 11 recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in 12 Sections 1 and 2.

Section 4. This act shall become effective
immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
its otherwise becoming law.
